For example, receiving an "A," which is assigned four grade points, in a three-semester-hour course would produce 12 honor points. The grade point average (GPA) is obtained by dividing the total honor points by the total number of semester hours graded A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, D, E, EN, EU, or XE. Other grades do not carry grade points. Semester GPA is based on semester net hours. Cumulative GPA is based on total net hours. Note: Although the plus/minus scale includes a grade of A+ with a value of 4.33, the cumulative GPA is capped at 4.00, except for Law students. Repeating Courses: An undergraduate course taken at ASU may be repeated for credit if the grade of X, D, E, EN, EU, XE or W was received.
