Pasadena Junior College's name was changed to Pasadena City College in 1947. In 1953, the two four-year junior colleges were combined into a single college. Pasadena City College, serving freshman and sophomores. The Pasadena Area Junior College District formation was approved by the voters and became effective July, 1 1967. The name became Pasadena Area Community College District on September 10, 1970.
