Accreditation: Berklee College of Music has been continuously accredited by the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE), formerly known as New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC), Commission on Institutions of Higher Education (CIHE), since 1973. Berklee College of Music was formerly named Schillinger House (1945–1953) and Berklee School of Music (1954– 1969). Prior to merging with Berklee in June 2016, Boston Conservatory at Berklee was named The Boston Conservatory. The Boston Conservatory was separately accredited by NEASC from 1968 until the 2016 merger.

Academic Calendar: The academic year consists of a fall and spring semester with an optional summer semester.

Unit of Credit: For lecture and discussion courses, students generally earn one course credit for every 15 class contact hours. For lecture and discussion courses, there is the expectation that one hour of class time per week requires two hours of outside class work each week.

For most ensembles and instrumental labs, students earn one hour of credit for every 30 hours of in-class time, or one credit for two contact hours each week.

Private instruction is delivered as a 2-credit, 1-hour per week course, or as a 1-credit, 30-minute per week course. Private instruction requires significant weekly expectations regarding practice time and study outside of class.

How the Grade Point Average is Calculated: Each letter grade has a grade point equivalent as listed. To calculate the GPA, multiply each

grade point equivalent by the number of credits for each class, total all products, and divide by the number of credits from all graded courses.

Dean's List: Students are placed on the dean's list each semester for meeting the following criteria based on grades collected by week two of the subsequent semester:

- 1. Students must achieve a minimum GPA of 3.50, regardless of credit load.
- 2. No grade may be lower than 'B', and no grade of Incomplete ('I') or Withdrawal ('W').

Dean's list designation is not indicated for terms prior to fall 1999.

Berklee College of Music does not rank students.

Repeated Courses Policy: Students may enroll in a course for a second or subsequent time. Only the highest grade will be computed into the cumulative grade point average. By repeating courses, the credit earned is not applicable toward graduation. The other instances of the courses are designated by the letter "R" (replaced) and will remain on the student's record, while the grades earned will be calculate in the semester GPA.

The Repeated Course Policy does not apply to ensembles, instrumental labs, and unleveled private instruction.

Course Numbering: With few exceptions, courses taken as of Summer 1999 are numbered as follows:

Course numbering prior to summer 1999 did not define the level of the course.

Programs of Study: Berklee College has three undergraduate programs of study: a 4-Year Bachelor of Music degree (requiring 120 credits or above); a 4-Year Professional Diploma (requiring 96 credits); and a 2-Year Artist Diploma (requiring 48 credits). Double majors typically require an additional 30 credits. Berklee also offers a program for non-matriculated attendance during the summer.
