McDaniel College is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. McDaniel College is an independent coeducational liberal arts college offering programs leading to a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science (until 1975), Master of Education (until 1986), Master of Science, and Master of Liberal Arts degrees.

McDaniel College operates on a semester system of fall, spring, Jan Term (undergrad only), and summer sessions.
