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McDaniel College was founded in 1867 as Western Maryland College. The name was changed to McDaniel College on July 1, 2002, by the College's Board of Trustees.

McDaniel College is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. McDaniel College is an independent co-educational liberal arts college offering programs leading to a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science (until 1975), Master of Education (until 1986), Master of Science, and Master of Liberal Arts degrees.

McDaniel College operates on a semester system of fall, spring, Jan Term (undergrad only), and summer sessions.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM

Semester hours required for graduation in the undergraduate program:
1995-96 to present - 128*
1978-79 to 1994-95 - 120

*Effective with the Summer 1995 sessions, the College switched to a 4-credit course system. The Freshman class and those following are now required to complete 128 hours to graduate.

100 or 1000 level – freshman courses
200 or 2000 level – sophomore courses
300 or 3000 level – junior courses
400 or 4000 level – senior courses

EXPLANATION OF GRADES

AU	Indicates the student audited the course. No hours and no quality points are awarded.

CR	Indicates student received credit for C- level work or above in an undergraduate course or B level work or above in a graduate level course.
I	Indicates the student has not completed the work in the course and has acceptable reasons.
IP	In progress.
NR	Indicates the instructor did not report a grade.
P	Indicates the student has successfully completed a course.
R	Indicates the student has repeated the course in a subsequent semester.
W	Indicates student withdrew from course(s) after the last date specified.
WF	Indicates student withdrew from the College after the last date specified, while receiving a failing grade in the course.
WP	Indicates student withdrew from the College after the last date specified, while receiving a passing grade in the course.
