I hired Kelly last October to work as a physical therapy technician, and one of the first things that struck me about her is her passion and enthusiasm for learning. Since our first meeting, I have seen her work with others in our space and met with her one-on-one, and that excitement has persisted. When we first started having regular meetings, she was torn about whether she wanted to pursue a career in physical therapy, which is what brought her to work in our space, or to return to an exploration of the natural world and our place in it. I encouraged her to think deeply about what resonated with her and brought her the most joy, and by our next meeting, she was resolved. Delivering that news, I could see she was concerned about disappointing me, by not following the same path I had, but it was clear that her heart was in nature and how to find her place there as a learner and advocate. I strongly feel that her excitement and connection to the environment will serve her well in a Master level program. Kelly has already sought out opportunities to get more involved in the ecology space, by volunteering at The Puget Sound Estuarium, and I know that is just a start for her. She has demonstrated strength in advocacy, pursuing ideals, and the importance of education as a means for justice, and I think she is a perfect fit for the Master of Environmental Studies Program.
