## RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES

### RESEARCH EXPERIENCE SUMMARY

My interest and passion are to understand and implement best practices in providing care for underrepresented and marginalized groups faced with difficult outcomes. My goal is to find ways to support communities of people challenged by trauma to be their best selves, have positive outcomes, and lead healthy lives. For over sixteen years, I have supported various Principal Investigators engaged in research that aim to promote health and well-being by managing their studies, study teams, proposals, and awards. In the last eight years, I have been able to assist the investigators with whom I work, to further their purposes of understanding and developing evidence-based practices that stimulates the growth of more positive and healthy lives for diverse vulnerable communities.

From early 1999 through 2000, I was introduced to research through my work as a scientific research photographer and graphic designer at Baylor College of Medicine's Children Nutrition Research Center which housed a broadly focused department of investigators. At that time, I worked with investigators in various stages of their careers to photograph their subjects (plant, animal, and synthetic) and design their scientific presentations in both computer and poster formats. Later, in 2008, I returned to the research field by joining Kaiser Permanente's (KP) Cancer Clinical Trials Access Program (CCTAP) in the Department of Research and Evaluation at Southern California Permanente Medical Group (SCPMG). At CCTAP, I supported a regional team of cancer investigators, research nurses, and clinical research assistants at fourteen different sites across Southern California. CCTAP was led by Dr. Jonathan Polikoff, Principal Investigator and Dr. Han Koh who in 2013 joined Dr. Polikoff as a multi-principal investigator team. Our CCTAP clinical trials focused on a spectrum of cancers sponsored by various co-operative groups (e.g. CALGB, SWOG, ECOG) and industry sponsors (e.g. Eli Lilly, Genentech, Gilead, Exelixis, Merck, and Pfizer). My responsibilities varied throughout the department and included budget, regulatory, staff, patient chart, FDA audit, and general department administrative and management duties.

I joined the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences (DPBS) in 2015 as the Program Manager for Dr. Marina Tolou-Shams' Juvenile Justice Behavioral Health Research Program (JJBH) where under Dr. Tolou-



Shams' leadership I managed all aspects of the program including staff, studies, and awards sponsored primarily by National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) R01s and a National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) R21. Our program engaged in mixed-methods research that focused on reducing health disparities and improving health outcomes in at-risk and justice-involved youth and adults. While on the team, JJBH's field of study expanded to examine evidence-based practices of safety for domestic violence victims who are in contact with law enforcement through a study which was funded by the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of Violence Against Women (OVW) through a local county contract.

In 2018, I left the JJBH team to join Dr. James Sorensen's UCSF Substance Abuse Research Program (SARP) where, in addition to supporting R01 and R21-level research studies, I broadened my research support to include a large NIDA Clinical Trials Network (CTN) U01 grant and various CTN studies as part of the Western States Node (WSN) prime award team, a NIDA T32 training grant, and a NIDA R25 educational grant all of which focus on expanding the addictions research field through increasing addictions research studies and researchers. The NIDA R25 Learning for Early Careers in Addiction and Diversity (LEAD) program specifically aims to grow the field of addictions research by preparing racial and ethnic minority early-stage addictions researchers across the U.S. to expand their research career by providing training and support in order to assist and prepare them for self-supported NIH grant funding. In this program, I aided in recruiting promising scholars and supporting them through their three years in the program. Additionally, I strengthened the NIDA T32 Postdoctoral Training Program in Substance Use Disorders Treatment and Services Research by increasing recruitment and training efforts for postdoctoral fellows whose goals are to enter a career that includes addictions research in diverse fields and focuses. While at SARP, I began to support Dr. Derek Satre, a clinical psychologist and professor at UCSF DPBS and adjunct investigator at KP Northern California Division of Research, focused on clinical trials of behavioral interventions to reduce substance use. While at SARP, I also supported Dr. Mandana Khalili, a very active research hepatologist at UCSF and Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital and Trauma Center (ZSFG), focused on liver disease and related disparities in vulnerable populations. Under Dr. Khalili, I assisted in writing and managing grant proposals to various federal, industry, and university sponsors in addition to staff development and support.

I joined the Division of Substance Abuse and Addiction Medicine (DSAAM) in Summer of 2021 as the Division Administrator under Dr. David Andrew Tompkins while still supporting SARP. There I learned the intricacies of managing substance use clinics supported by City and County contracts while still maintaining my role in research administration for other Divisions.

In Summer of 2022, while still at DSAAM, I began to support Dr. Lisa Fortuna, Vice Chair of DBPS and Chief of Psychiatry at ZSFG, and her endeavor to develop a behavioral health research center for, with, and by the community. We began with the support of a NIH Common Fund/NIMH sponsored U01 entitled, "By Youth, For Youth: Digital Supported Peer Navigation for Addressing Child Mental Health Inequities" among other smaller grants. Dr. Fortuna was offered to be Professor and Chair of Psychiatry and Neurosciences at University of California, Riverside (UCR) and began August 2023. She requested I continue with her at UCR as Director of Community Responsive and Engaged Equity Research (CREER) in Mental Health, a center for research, education, and community leadership. Since our arrival at UCR, we received, as research partners in support of the community organization Cultura y Arte Nativa de las Americas (CANa) a NIH-sponsored Community Partnerships to Advance Science for Society (ComPASS) award, "Somos Esenciales: Community Revitalization and Health Through Arts and Entrepreneurship," (Award Number: 1OT2OD035895-01). This study is a multifaceted intervention research project to promote health equity and lasting change for Native, Latino, and Black communities in the San Francisco Mission District by using a cultural programming and indigenous healing informed community development strategy.

My current primary responsibilities are to expand CREER in Mental Health through faculty recruitment, submission of various grant proposals, and administration of studies and awards. I also continue to support faculty research portfolios for Dr. Michelle Porche as well as Drs. Caravella McCuistian, Leslie Suen, Meredith Meacham, and Alexander Bazazi, early-stage investigators for whom I assist to develop their research portfolios, staff, and lab at UCSF/ZSFG. I am currently responsible for over 14 studies and contracts and am in the process of developing and/or submitting 7 additional grant proposals, including a NIH P-level center proposal. Additionally, I oversee two department divisions of faculty and staff at UCR and UCSF.
