Scientific Survey of Local Gull Populations September - December 2021

The Evergreen State College | Olympia, WA

- Used primary scientific literature to research the morphologies, habitats, and behaviors of local gull bird species in the Puget Sound region.
- Picked out and drove to four locations (two urban and two rural) in Thurston County to conduct several field surveys using common identification techniques to count the total number, the ages, and the species of gull.
- Found a higher occurrence of young birds in urban environments, and wrote a final scientific report with references to primary literature to place the results in the context of existing research.

Scientific Research Proposal On Sustainable Agriculture and Perennial Polyculture January - March 2022

- Collaborated with a team to research, design, write and present a scientific research proposal on Perennial Polyculture and its potential ecological benefits as an alternative agricultural production system.
