
The university is on a semester basis. Sixteen (16) weeks to a semester. One-hundred-twenty (120) credits and a 2.0 cumulative average are normally required to earn an undergraduate degree. To graduate from the nursing program of the College of Nursing and Health Sciences, a student must complete 123 credits as a Nursing major or 120 credits as a RN-BSN major.

Boston State College was closed by action of the Massachusetts State Legislature effective January 24, 1982. The University of Massachusetts Boston became the certifying agent for course work taken at Boston State College. Transcripts issued by the Registrar's Office at the University of Massachusetts Boston for all students enrolled at Boston State College prior to its closing will carry the heading of "Boston State College". Transcripts for students who were enrolled at the University of Massachusetts Boston as a result of this merger will have a record which reflects work taken at both institutions. Some of the students will still have transcripts that carry the seal of the University of Massachusetts Boston and the signature of the Registrar and are considered to be an official transcript for that student.
