The Statistics course CLEP (College Level Examination Program) test administered at the Education Office at Joint Base Lewis/McChord is a standardized test that assesses a student's understanding of introductory statistics concepts typically covered in a college-level course. The test demonstrates their knowledge of topics such as descriptive statistics, probability, inferential statistics, and data analysis. By passing this exam, students can earn college credit for an introductory statistics course without having to take the actual class.
