The College operates on a quarter calendar. Grades A through D-, P and S are considered passing. P, S, and U identify courses taken on a pass/fail basis and are not counted in computing grade point averages. P and S are given only if student does C or better work. U is given if student does C- or less work. College level courses are 100 level or above. Courses notated as repeated are not calculated into the G PA.

Degree Requirements:

Associate in Arts; Associate in Arts and Science; Associate in Science—Transfer; Associate in Applied Science—Transfer; Associate in Applied Science; Associate in Applied Technology; Associate in Fine Arts. These degrees require a minimum of 90 credit hours plus prescribed curriculum. Bachelor of Applied Science degrees require a minimum of 180 credit hours plus prescribed curriculum. A degree title preceded by the # sign or succeeded by DTA signifies an I.C.R.C., approved transfer degree. Certificates of Proficiency are notated as CP, Certificates of Achievement are notated as CA, and Certificates of Completion are notated as CC. See the current Clark College Catalog and updated information for degree and certificate requirements.

Academic Honors:

A Vice President's List recognizing student achievement will be compiled quarterly with an appropriate notation made on the transcript. To qualify, a student must earn both 1.) At least 12 credits and 2.) A grade point average of at least 3.75. Prior to Summer 1999, Highest Honors at graduation are proclaimed for students who earn a GPA of 4.00. Honors at graduation proclaimed for students who earn a GPA of 3.40 through 3.89. Beginning Summer 1999, Highest Honors at graduation are proclaimed for students who earn a GPA of 3.40 through 3.89. Certificates of Proficiency will be granted the designation of With Merit for a GPA of 3.40 or higher.

Accreditation:

The Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities and the Washington State Board accredits Clark College for Community and Technical Colleges. In addition, some degree programs have been accredited and/or certified by professional accrediting associations.
