Electric Vehicles and Their Environment - Sustainability Capstone

August 2022 - December 2022

For my Sustainability Capstone project, I worked in collaboration with my classmates to study electric vehicles while working with the company Drive Electric TN and TDEC. and did research for them on adoption rates and emissions. Software used included ArcGIS Pro, StoryMaps, and Excel. Our extensive research covered the emissions reduction due to an increase in EVs, which counties in Knoxville have the most EVs, the economic difference in an EV vs. a gasoline-powered vehicle, and data collection and organization.

USPS Pollinator Garden - *GEOL 454: Environmental Restoration*

August 2022 - December 2022

During the fall of my Junior year I worked with 3 other students on a restoration project for class. We worked in collaboration with Native Plant Rescue Squad as well as Keep Knoxville Beautiful, who funded the restoration. We transformed a barren patch of grass in front of the United States Post Office on North Broadway into a blossoming pollinator garden through the removal of invasives and plotting of pollinator-friendly plants.
