My name is James Gordon, and I have been the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer (THPO) in the Cultural Resources Department of the Cowlitz Indian Tribe since January 2024. Prior to that, I was the Cultural Resources Technician for the Cowlitz Indian Tribe since 2007. I am writing this letter to recommend Rita Asgeirsson for the Master of Environmental Science Program at Evergreen State University.

Rita was the Cultural Resources Director for the Cowlitz Indian Tribe (and my immediate supervisor) from the middle of June 2021 until early December 2023. I learned a great deal from her during this time, and she enlightened me on many topics such as Tribal sovereignty and energy policies. Her knowledge of various topics having to do with the intersections of Tribal policies (from a Native professional perspective) allowed me to glean further insight as to the field that I have been working in for over a decade.
