Accreditation

A normal course load is three to five units a semester. Introductory courses are numbered 100-199; intermediate 200-299 and advanced courses 300-399. Regular Massachusetts Institute of Technology courses taken in accordance with an exchange agreement are preceded by the letters MT or MIT.

Each unit is equivalent to four semester hours or six quarter hours. For purposes of transfer, units are evaluated in terms of the proportion of work accomplished toward the A.B. degree in the college from which a student transfers credits (e.g. 60 semester hours from a college requiring 120 for graduation would be computed as 16 Wellesley units.)

1. 32 units of academic work with a C average or better
2. All required work in the major field(s)
3. At least four units of 300 level courses, at least two of which shall be in the major
4. Distribution of courses across the curriculum
5. Foreign language
6. Multicultural
7. Writing
8. Physical education

Honors

Honors in the major field are awarded by vote of a committee (ordinarily based on a thesis and oral presentation) and are designated below the date of the degree.

Academic Distinction

First Year Distinction is awarded for a 3.33 average or better for 7 or more completed units in the first year. Discontinued starting with the Class of 2010.

Latin Honors are awarded based on an average calculated for courses taken after the first year (for students entering before Fall 2009) or after the first semester (for students entering Fall 2009 and later), provided that eligibility requirements have been met.
