While my previous social science and statistics courses were taken over five years ago (Statistics 412 – Fall 2019 & Economics 101 – Spring 2019), both subject areas have remained relevant to my most recent coursework and my current career in aquaculture.

In the fall of 2021, I took Population Ecology (SOE 441) and Habitat Ecology (SOE 446), both of which required the use of statistical methods and applied them within a wildlife ecology context. After graduating, I continued to refine my statistical skills. During my internship at Hudson Valley Fisheries, I worked on a research project that required statistical analysis. Specifically, when taking rate-of-flow measurements, I used a statistical program to identify the most statistically significant data points.

Regarding the social sciences, I have taken multiple courses that integrated social science principles with environmental studies. Specifically, in the spring of 2022, I completed Natural Resources and Public Land Policy (SOE 438), a course that examined the economic, social, and anthropological impacts of environmental policy on society.
