Explanation of Transcript For Students Who Have Attended 1978-1979 and Subsequently

The academic year at Whitman College consists of two semesters of approximately fifteen weeks each. A minimum of 124 credits is required for graduation.

ACCREDITATIONS AND AFFILIATIONS

Whitman College is accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities and the American Chemical Society.

COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

Before 1983-84 courses were numbered 1-99 with no designation as to upper and lower division.

Whitman College converted to a three-digit course numbering system in the fall semester of 1983-84. The first digit indicates the general level of the course; 100, Introductory; 200 and 300, Intermediate; 400, Advanced. The second digit may be used by the department to designate types of courses or the sequence within the general level. The third digit is used to differentiate individual courses and provide information concerning sequences.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

Total number of grade points earned divided by the total number of graded credits attempted. Work completed in off-campus programs and transfer credit are not included in the computation of grade averages.

OFF CAMPUS PROGRAMS

Beginning with the 1982-83 academic year, grades earned in the affiliated off-campus programs are recorded on the student's Whitman College record for informational purposes but are not included in the computation of grade point averages. For a list of programs, please reference the appropriate Whitman College catalog, Special Programs Section. Prior to 1982-83 the grades for work in the off-campus programs were entered as Credit or No Credit with the exception of the ILACA Program, which was graded on a regular basis.

Courses listed under the summer header were completed through Whitman College, but may have been taught abroad. Some of these courses are taught by Whitman faculty and thus apply toward the Whitman grade point average. Courses taught by faculty at other institutions do not factor into the Whitman grade point average and are transcribed as such.

TRANSCRIPT NOTATIONS

The following information notations are used in the column following grade points:

- # Course graded on a P-D-Fail basis, no other grade option is available to student.
- * Credit not allowed toward degree; credit limitation is exceeded.
- R Credit not allowed toward degree; repeat of course previously completed for degree credit.

GRADE CORRECTIONS AND CONVERSIONS

Grades may be changed only with the approval of the Board of Review and for reasons normally limited to the correction of clerical errors. The original grade does not appear on the permanent record.

Transcripts issued to the student are stamped indicating their release to the student and provided in a sealed envelope.
