You may use work that you have completed previously, as long as your final document meets the requirements for the academic writing sample. Please note, your essay should be a demonstration of individual work, group or team-based projects and essays will not be accepted.

GRE SCORES

You may submit GRE Scores that are up to 5 years old from the date you plan to submit your application. For example, if you took the GRE on September 19, 2020, you may access and submit your scores from ETS until September 18, 2025.

If you have not yet taken the GRE, you will need to ensure that you take the test in time for your scores to be submitted to the Graduate Admissions office by the application deadline you are applying for. It takes ETS 10-15 working days from your test date to send your scores to your college(s) of interest.
