Prerequisite Information

All courses will be completed through Shoreline Community College. The specific classes for each requirement are described below:

Natural Sciences (FALL 2024)

Introduction to Environmental Science—An introduction to ecology, ecosystems, and natural cycles. Includes an examination of the effects of political, economic, and social systems on the environment.

Social Sciences (WINTER 2025)

Cultural Anthropology—An examination of cultural and social diversity within the United States and globally. Focuses on cross-cultural comparisons of topics such as power, health, religion, and language.

Statistics (SPRING 2025)

Introduction to Statistics—Introduces methods for analyzing data through graphical and numerical means. Focuses on linear regression, normal distribution, data collection, probability, confidence intervals, and hypothesis testing with an emphasis on application.
