Courses graded with S, P, H or under Forgiveness are not counted in the cumulative average but are counted toward total hours earned.

Courses graded with U, F, I, IP, W, WN, WP, WF, AU, NR or Z are not counted in the cumulative average nor in hours earned.

REPEATED COURSES: (Starting spring 1992)

The letters I and E next to a grade have been used to indicate that the course has been repeated and the particular grade included (I) or excluded (E) from the G.P.A. calculation. According to our policy only the included grade should be considered for G.P.A. when a course is repeated to improve a grade. Only courses with a grade of D+, D, D- or E can be repeated for that purpose. In certain instances, an include/exclude indicator will also appear next to lecture/lab courses to ensure that credit is granted for both the lecture and lab. Additionally, topics courses will also have include/exclude indicators since multiple instances of the same course number can be repeated within their respective course repeat limits.
