HISTORY OF NAU

Northern Arizona Normal School opened its doors on September 11, 1899, to a class of twenty-three students. In 1925 the Arizona Legislature approved the school as a four-year, degree-conferring college with a bachelor of education degree and a name change to Northern Arizona State Teachers College. Four years later the name changed to Arizona State Teachers College at Flagstaff.

With the addition of several other degree offerings, the "teachers" component of the name was eliminated on June 11, 1945, changing the name to Arizona State College. On May 1, 1966, the institution became Northern Arizona University.

ACCREDITATION

Northern Arizona University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. Programs in the various colleges, schools, divisions, and departments are accredited by or affiliated with various national bodies.

TRANSCRIPTS FROM OTHER INSTITUTIONS

Northern Arizona University does not issue copies of transcripts (high school or university) or other documents received from other institutions.
