### ACCREDITATION

The University of San Francisco is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC).

#### AREA OF CONCENTRATION

When posted, an area of concentration represents completion of specific coursework within the major; it is posted only with the conferral of the major and the degree.

#### **MINOR**

When posted, a minor represents completion of specific coursework external to the major; it is posted only with the conferral of the major and the degree.

#### **CERTIFICATES OR SPECIAL CREDENTIALS**

When posted, a certificate or credential program represents completion of specific coursework as specified in the University Catalog.

#### **REPEATED COURSES**

Courses may be repeated. Both the initial grade and the subsequent repeat grades will show on the academic record and count in the Quality Points (GPA); however, the units earned in the repeated courses will not be included in the total needed for a degree conferral unless indicated otherwise in the University Catalog.

#### **UNIVERSITY HONORS**

To be considered for University Honors, an undergraduate student must have completed at least 60 units of academic coursework graded "A" through "F" at USF and have a minimum USF grade point average of 3.50.

#### SCHOOL/COLLEGE HONORS

The School of Nursing and Health Professions students are eligible for School Honors with a USF grade point average of 3.5 or above. Professional Bachelor's Degree students in the School of Management are eligible for School High Honors with a USF grade point average of 3.9 or above or School Honors for those earning a USF grade point average of 3.7 to 3.89.

#### **FACULTY ASSESSED LEARNING**

Through the Experiential Learning/Assessment Center of the University, undergraduate college credit may be earned for learning that has taken place outside the traditional college classroom. Although no grade and quality points are awarded, the units are applicable toward the baccalaureate but may not be posted unless the student has successfully completed core program units. The faculty assessed learning process is not a basis for verification of enrollment or unit load for a term.
