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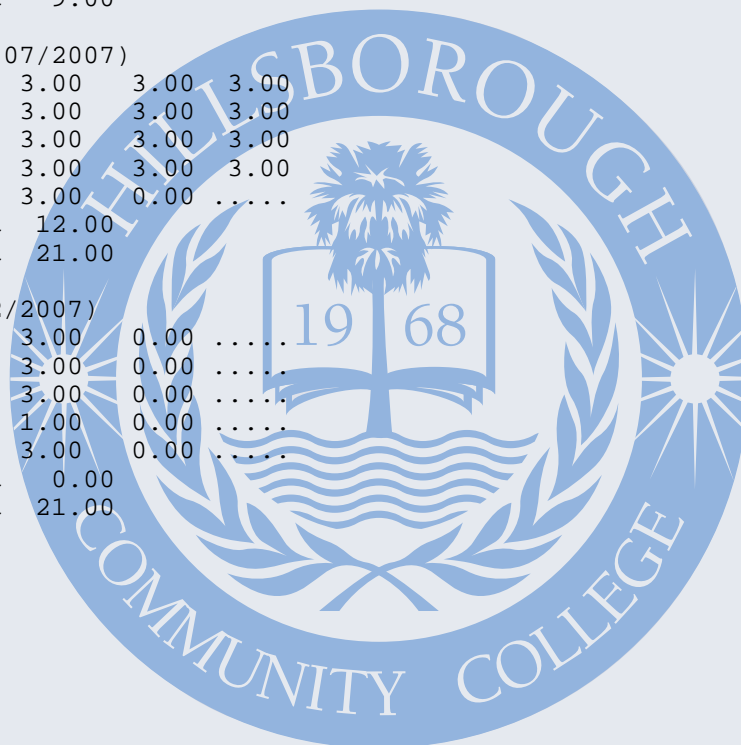

ACCREDITATION:

The College began in the Fall of 1968. It is fully accredited by the Florida State Department of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

The Associate in Arts degree is the degree designed for transfer to upper division universities. It is protected by the Articulation Agreement among all Florida public institutions of higher education. By the terms of the agreement, a student who is awarded an Associate in Arts degree by Hillsborough Community College has met the general education requirements for admission to the upper division public universities of the State of Florida.

FLORIDA STATEWIDE COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM:

The course numbers appearing on this transcript are part of the statewide system of prefixes and numbers developed for use by all public postsecondary and participating private institutions in Florida. One of the major purposes of this system is to make transferring easier by identifying courses which are equivalent, no matter where they are taught in the state. All courses designed as equivalent will carry the same prefix and last three digits.

HCC UNIT OF CREDIT:

Hillsborough Community College awards semester credits. One semester credit is given normally for a class that meets 50 minutes per week for approximately 16 weeks. Semester credits are also given in short terms but the classes meet longer and more frequently each week.

CREDITS TRANSFERRED FROM OTHER COLLEGES TO HCC:

Degree seeking students have all credits attempted at other colleges evaluated and previous attempts are computed in the cumulative grade point average where applicable.

REPEATED COURSES:

All grades remain on the record, but only the last grade earned is used in the computation unless course is an allowed repeat.

ACADEMIC TERMS:

Hillsborough Community College normally has the following four terms each academic year.

DEGREES GRANTED:

Associate in Arts - A two-year degree which includes a required core of General Education credits.

Associate in Science - A two-year degree awarded to students who successfully completed one of the Technical Programs.

Associate in Applied Science - A two-year degree awarded to students who successfully completed one of the Technical Programs.

GRADUATION WITH HONORS:

Students receiving an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, or Associate in Applied Science degree are eligible for the following honor designations:

Honors:	Cumulative grade point average of 3.50 - 3.79
High Honors:	Cumulative grade point average of 3.80 - 3.99
Highest Honors:	Cumulative grade point average of 4.00

CERTIFICATES GRANTED:

College Credit Certificate - A certificate awarded to students in selected areas of the technical field for programs of less than two years.
