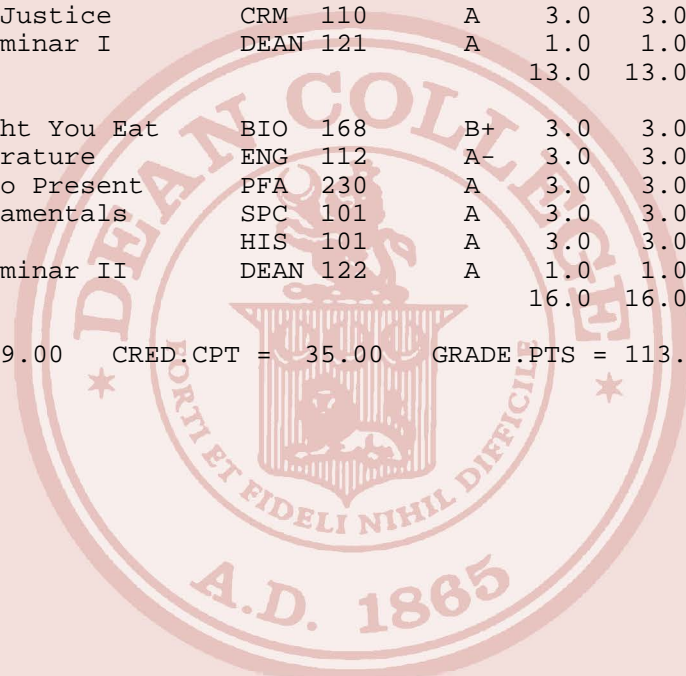

CALENDAR SYSTEM – Dean College operates on two 14 week semesters. Selected courses offered during summer, four-week, six-week, and ten-week accelerated sessions.

DEVELOPMENTAL COURSES – All courses with a course number of ENG 086, ENG 087, ENG 088, ENG 089, ENG 097, ENG 098, ENG 099, FYS 099, CIS 097, CIS 098, CIS 099 or MTH 099 are developmental in nature. Credits are not counted towards graduation requirements.

BRIDGE PROGRAM – Bridge was a four-week summer residential program specifically designed to assist students to refine their study skills prior to entering college.

Spring 2020 The COVID-19 pandemic in Spring 2020 required unanticipated online delivery mid-semester for the majority of courses. As a result, students were provided the option of selecting pass or no credit grades in lieu of traditional letter grades.

REPEATED COURSE POLICY – When courses are repeated at Dean College, the highest grade is used in the GPA calculation, with both grades remaining on the transcript. Repeated activity is noted with a “repeated” notation when course credit has been repeated.

CREDIT HOURS – All credits awarded are semester hours of credit, regardless of the length of the term.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) – The GPA is determined by dividing the sum of the Quality Points earned at Dean College by the sum of the attempted semester credit hours which carry quality points.

TRANSFER CREDIT - The Registrar evaluates transfer credit only for courses that apply toward the Dean degree in which a grade of C- or better has been earned.
