CREDIT SYSTEM AND CALENDAR:

Credits are listed as semester credit hours. A semester is normally 16 weeks in duration. The summer semester is 8 weeks. Some courses may vary in length, but are equated to semester hours.

NUMBERING SYSTEM:

The first digit indicates the class level and the last digit indicates the credit hours awarded for the course:

- 0000 Remedial courses (no college credit)
- 1000 Freshman level courses
- 2000 Sophomore level courses
- 3000 Junior level courses
- 4000 Senior level courses
- 5000 Graduate level courses

COURSE LOAD:

Twelve semester hours during a regular fall or spring semester and six semester hours in a summer session constitutes full-time enrollment for the undergraduate student. Full-time status for the graduate student is nine semester hours during a regular fall or spring semester and four semester hours in a summer session.

RETENTION GPA:

For all undergraduate students enrolled Fall 1992 or later, forgiven courses identified by E are not used in calculating the retention grade point average, but are used in calculating the cumulative grade point average. Repeated courses identified by an A are used in calculating the retention and cumulative grade point averages, but will not satisfy any credit hour requirements. Beginning with the Fall 1994 semester, the retention GPA also excludes physical education activity courses.
