UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO: The University of Idaho was established by statute of the 15th territorial legislature in 1889. The University of Idaho is the land-grant institution for the state of Idaho and designated as a Carnegie Doctoral/Research-Extensive institution. The University is composed of 10 colleges, including Law, and four centers: University of Idaho – Boise, University of Idaho – Coeur d’Alene, University of Idaho – Idaho Falls, University of Idaho – Twin Falls.

ACCREDITATION: The University of Idaho is accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. For additional approval, or accreditation for specific programs, see the University of Idaho Catalog.

CREDIT HOURS: All credit hours on the University of Idaho transcript are computed in semester hours. A semester is 16 weeks in duration.

RELEASE OF INFORMATION: This transcript has been forwarded to you at the request of the student with the requirement that it will not be released to other parties. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, prohibits release of this information without the student’s written consent.

TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION: Transfer credits evaluated prior to Spring 1997 may appear as a pre-system cumulative summary instead of accepted transfer credit due to a system conversion.

CHANGE IN TRANSFER GRADING POLICY: Prior to Spring 1997, students who attended another institution and returned to the University of Idaho were allowed to transfer both credits and grades earned. Beginning Spring 1997, and thereafter, the University of Idaho accepts transfer credit but does not compute grades from other colleges and universities in its institutional GPA.

REPEATING COURSES: Courses may be repeated for grade improvement per regulations in the University of Idaho Catalog. Although all grades remain on the record, course grades notated with an E are Excluded from the GPA and credits, course grades notated with an I are Included in the GPA and credits, and course grades notated with an A are Averaged into the GPA.

FRESH START: The University of Idaho has a forgiveness program for undergraduate students who left the University with less than a 2.00 GPA and have not attended any institutions of higher education for the preceding five years. Successful admission to this program allows students to maintain all earned hours, but remove the original GPA. Admission to this program is specifically noted on the transcript.

COURSE NOTATIONS: Courses may have comments listed below them providing specific information about the course. ISI designates that the course was completed through Independent Study in Idaho. The date in the comment indicates when the course was completed and the course and comment are recorded in the semester of registration.

GPA LINES ON THE TRANSCRIPT: The transcript lists three lines of cumulative GPA information:

- Line 1 indicates the University of Idaho cumulative hours and grade point average: the GPA in Line 1 is the official University of Idaho grade point average.
- Line 2 indicates transfer credit totals with transfer grade point average.
- Line 3 indicates an overall credit summary with a combined GPA. The total earned hours listed in Line 3 represents the student’s total official credit accumulation.
