UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO: The University of Idaho was established by statute of the 15th territorial legislature in 1889. The University of Idaho is the landgrant institution for the state of Idaho and designated as a Carnegie Doctoral/Research-Extensive institution. The University is composed of 10 colleges, including Law, and four centers: University of Idaho – Boise, University of Idaho – Coeur d'Alene, University of Idaho – Idaho Falls, University of Idaho – Twin Falls.

ACCREDITATION: The University of Idaho is accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. For additional approval, or accreditation for specific programs, see the University of Idaho Catalog. CREDIT HOURS: All credit hours on the University of Idaho transcript are computed in semester hours. A semester is 16 weeks in duration. TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION: Transfer credits evaluated prior to Spring 1997 may appear as a pre-system cumulative summary instead of accepted transfer credit due to a system conversion.

CHANGE IN TRANSFER GRADING POLICY: Prior to Spring 1997, students who attended another institution and returned to the University of Idaho were allowed to transfer both credits and grades earned. Beginning Spring 1997, and thereafter, the University of Idaho accepts transfer credit but does not compute grades from other colleges and universities in its institutional GPA. **REPEATING COURSES:** Courses may be repeated for grade improvement per regulations in the University of Idaho Catalog. Although all grades remain on the record, course grades notated with an E are Excluded from the GPA and credits, course grades notated with an I are Included in the GPA and credits, and course grades notated with an A are Averaged into the GPA.
