UNIT OF CREDIT: Credits are reported as semester hours.

COURSE NUMBERING: Courses numbered 100–499 are undergraduate courses and carry no graduate credit. Graduate courses are numbered 500 and above.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE: Cumulative GPA is listed at the end of the transcript. GPA is figured by dividing total grade points by total credits attempted (GPA Hours). Courses marked with an asterisk (*) are excluded from the GPA.

Note: Prior to September 1, 1984, Pensacola Christian College was on a 3.0 scale. On that date, all records were converted to the 4.0 scale.

REPEATED COURSES: Prior to June 1, 1987, all credit hours attempted were figured into the GPA. From then until May 31, 1996, only the final attempt of a repeated course was used in the computation. Since June 1, 1996, only the highest earned grade of a repeated course is used in computing the grade point average.

ACADEMIC HONORS: Undergraduate students enrolled for 12 or more credits who earn at least a 3.0 GPA and earn no "D," "F," "WF," or "I" grades for the semester are eligible for the Dean's List. Undergraduate students enrolled for 12 or more credits who earn at least a 3.9 GPA are eligible for the President's List.

ACADEMIC STANDING: Good academic standing is implied unless otherwise noted. Students who fail to maintain a minimum GPA for their academic level may be placed on Academic Probation, Academic Suspension, or Academic Dismissal.
