

The Fletcher School and Friedman School use a two-semester academic calendar for all their degree programs except for Fletcher's Global Master of Arts Program (GMAP) and Global Business Administration (GBA) program, and Friedman's Master of Nutrition Science and Policy (MNSP), which use a full year three-term calendar.  
The Cummings School uses a two semester academic calendar for year 1-3 and an annual term for year 4 for its DVM program and a full year three-term academic calendar for its Masters & PhD programs  
The School of Dental Medicine uses an annual term for its DMD program.  
The Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences uses a full year three-term academic calendar.

**CREDIT**  
Unless otherwise noted, one semester hour equates to 1 hour of classroom or direct faculty instruction and a minimum of two hours of outside preparation each week by the student over a 15 week semester (or equivalent). For students who are active in the Summer 2018 term and beyond each course credit (1.0) is equivalent to 1.0 semester hours. For students who attended prior to Summer 2018 (except the School of Dental Medicine and the Cummings School) each course credit (1.0) was equivalent to 4.0 semester hours.
