### TRANSCRIPT NOTATIONS

Courses graded with a C- or better will be converted to a passing grade of EP and meet all graduation requirements. Courses graded with a D+ or lower shall be converted to EF and the student will not earn credit.

**Credit by Exam** – Students may challenge specific coursework and receive a "Satisfactory" grade.

### TRANSFER CREDIT

Grades for work transferred from another institution are not recorded.

**Military Credits** – Credits may be granted for military service upon proof of service and/or schooling.

**Vocational Technical Credits** – Under certain conditions the University will grant up to 45 credits for matriculated students who have had experience in industry.

**College Level Examination Program (CLEP)** – Test scores at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile or above accepted in some subject areas.

### QUARTER CREDITS

180 credits are required for graduation with a minimum 2.00 grade point average.
