CALENDAR AND CREDITS

Carroll College operates on a two-semester calendar; the fall semester runs late August to mid-December and the spring semester runs mid-January to mid-May; the summer session is optional for undergraduate students. One semester credit hour typically represents the work of 50 minutes of class time, meeting once weekly and requiring approximately two hours of preparation. One laboratory period (two to three hours) is equivalent to one class meeting.

GRADE SYSTEM AND HONOR POINTS

The 4.0 scale has been in use since 1958. Plus and minus grades were added to the grade scheme in Fall 2015. The minimum grade required for a student to receive credit is "D."

COURSE NUMBERS AND NOTATIONS

Courses numbered below 100 are not counted toward graduation.

Courses numbered 100-200 are lower division, 300-400 are upper division, and 500 and above are graduate level.

Beginning Fall 2003, courses meeting specific Core Curriculum requirements are noted as: GD (Global Diversity), ND (National Diversity), or WI (Writing Intensive).

Beginning Summer 2014, courses including "MM" in the number denote courses taught at the ISA study site in Meknes, Morocco, for which Carroll is the school of record.

Beginning Fall 2017, courses including "X" in the number denote an exception to the published catalog information.

TRANSFER CREDITS AND COURSE REPEATS

Grades earned at other institutions are not calculated into the Carroll College grade point average. Students who receive a grade of "D" or "F" may repeat the course at Carroll; in such cases, the most recent grade is used to compute the cumulative GPA. Courses repeated at other institutions do not change the Carroll cumulative GPA.

CORE CURRICULUM DESIGNATIONS

Graduates of Carroll who have fulfilled their Core Curriculum requirements through alternate means are noted with one of the following specializations as part of their degree: Honors Scholars Program, Post-Baccalaureate Student, or Transfer AA or AS Student.
