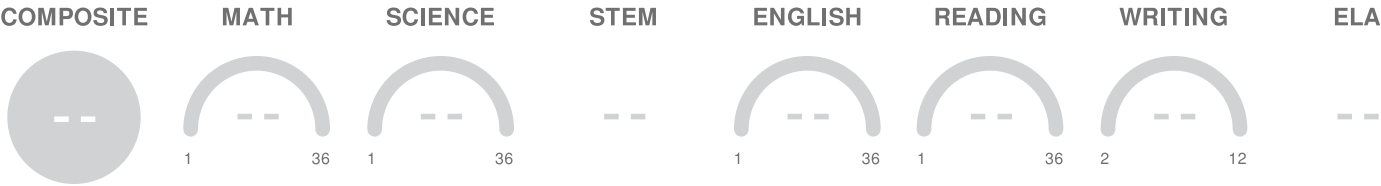

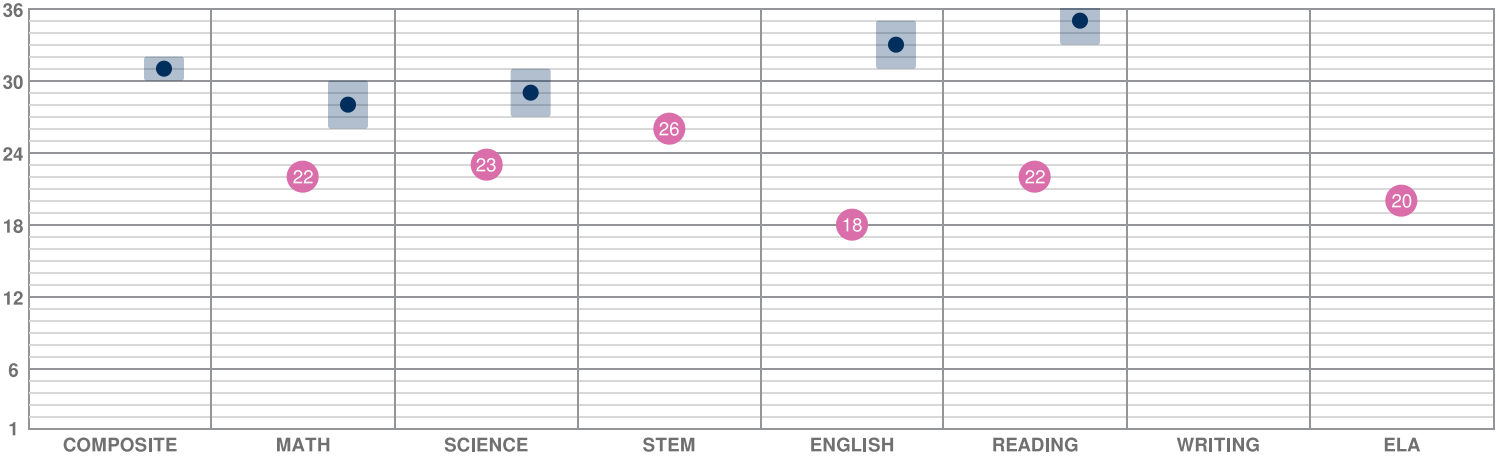
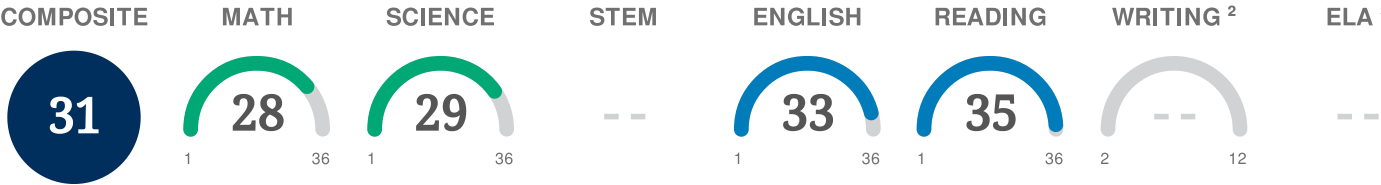
ACT Superscore ¹

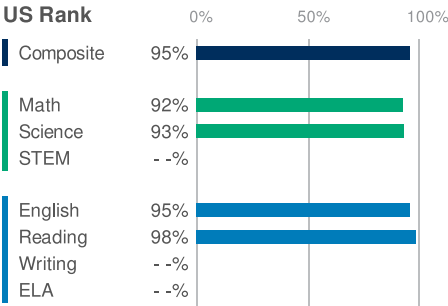


ACT College Readiness Benchmarks

Single Test Event: Student's Score Range

Test scores are estimates of the student's educational achievement. 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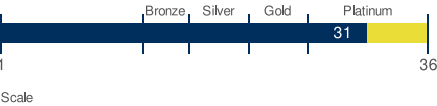

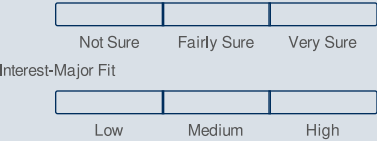
