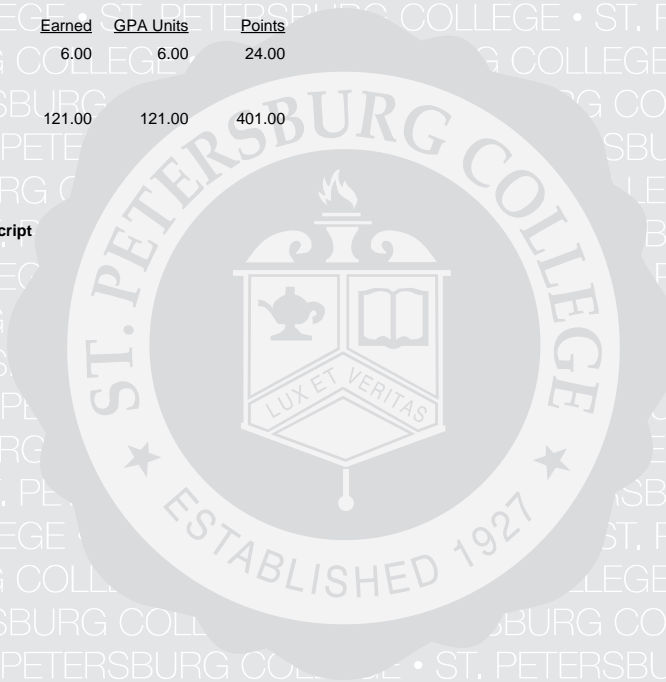

## STATE OF FLORIDA ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

The Associate in Arts degree is the degree designed for transfer to upper-division universities. It is protected by Florida statute and the articulation agreement among all Florida public postsecondary institutions. Under the terms of the agreement, students awarded an Associate in Arts by St. Petersburg College have met the general education requirements for admission to upper-division public universities in the state of Florida.

The course numbers appearing on this transcript are part of a statewide system of prefixes and numbers developed for use by all public postsecondary and participating private institutions in Florida. St. Petersburg College awards one semester credit for a class that meets 50 minutes per week for approximately 16 weeks. Semester credits also are awarded in shorter periods, but the classes have a longer duration and/or meet more frequently.
