### RECORDS SYSTEM

In January 1986, CWU adopted an electronic records system. Students enrolled prior to Winter 1986 have separate transcripts reflecting their previous course work.

# TRANSCRIPT NOTATIONS

**Advance Placement Credits-** (AP) – Students may receive credits for high school advanced placement examinations. Subject areas and earned credit are noted on transcript.

**Emergency Pass/Fail-** (EP/EF) – Provides an alternative to a letter grade in a major campus emergency. Courses graded with a C- or better will be converted to a passing grade of EP and meet all graduation requirements. Courses graded with a D+ or lower shall be converted to EF and the student will not earn credit.

Credit by Exam - Students may challenge specific coursework and receive a "Satisfactory" grade.

### TRANSFER CREDIT

Grades for work transferred from another institution are not recorded.

Military Credits - Credits may be granted for military service upon proof of service and/or schooling.

**Vocational Technical Credits** – Under certain conditions the University will grant up to 45 credits for matriculated students who have had experience in industry.

College Level Examination Program (CLEP) – Test scores at 50th percentile or above accepted in some subject areas.

### QUARTER CREDITS

180 credits are required for graduation with a minimum 2.00 grade point average.

### GRADE POINT AVERAGE

Grade point averages will be calculated by dividing grade points earned by the credit hours attempted. AHRS; Attempted Hours EHRS; Earned Hours
