Master of Arts in Teaching program: Through summer 2010 courses are recorded in credit units which are equivalent to 4 semester hours or 6 quarter hours. Beginning in fall 2010 credits are recorded in semester hours.

Professional Educator Program: Through summer 2010 credits are recorded in quarter hours. Beginning in fall 2010 credits are recorded in semester hours.

700-level courses with an ED prefix: Through spring 2011 credits are recorded in quarter hours. Beginning in summer 2011 credits are recorded in semester hours.

Oregon College of Art and Craft: Through summer 1999 credits are recorded in quarter hours. Beginning in fall 1999 credits are recorded in semester hours.

Pacific Northwest College of Art: Semester hours. Prior to 1981 Continuing Education Program credits are recorded in quarter hours

Undergraduate programs: Through summer 1967, and beginning again in fall 2021, credits are recorded in semester hours. Between fall 1967 and summer 2021, undergraduate courses are recorded in credit units which are equivalent to 4 semester hours or 6 quarter hours.

Course Numbering Systems

Atkinson Graduate School of Management: Courses with the BUS or GSM prefix: Prior to fall 1993, courses were numbered 100-399. From fall 1993 to summer 2012, courses were numbered 500-799. Beginning in fall 2012, courses are numbered 1000-7999. Courses with the GSMPR prefix are numbered 600-699. Certificate courses have a five letter prefix beginning with GSM __ or EDC__.

College of Law: Courses with the LAW prefix.

Graduate Programs: Courses are numbered 500 and above.

Graduate School of Education: Courses with an EDUC or EDM prefix are numbered 500-599. Courses with an ED, CET, EDAD, ENDR, SPED, PWS, or EDU prefix are numbered 500-799.

Oregon College of Art and Craft: 100-299 lower division;300-499 upper division: 500-699 graduate level:700-999 and 7000-9999 community education offered for no credit

Pacific Northwest College of Art: 100-200 lower division;300-400 upper division; 500-600 graduate level; Continuing Education Program credit is lower division unless otherwise noted.

Undergraduate programs: Prior to fall 1967, courses were numbered 001-499. From fall 1967 to summer 1981, courses were numbered 01-99. Since fall 1981, courses numbered 001-099, no credit toward graduation; 001X-099X and 100-299, lower division credit; and 300-499, upper division credit.

Repeated courses: Both attempts of a repeated course appear on the transcript. In the Atkinson Graduate School of Management and Pacific Northwest College of Art, both grades are calculated in the grade point average. In all other schools, only the attempt with the higher grades is computed in the grade point average. In all schools, credit is earned only once.

Disciplinary Sanctions: Effective June 2017, disciplinary (conduct) sanctions are indicated at the end of the semester in which they occur. This policy took effect for Pacific Northwest College of Art on July 1, 2021, when it merged with Willamette University.

Eligibility to Re-enroll: Policies are available on the university website.
