The grade point average expresses the academic performance of a student as a numerical weighted average. It is calculated by multiplying the grade points associated with the letter grade assigned for a course by the number of credit hours assigned to that course. Corresponding values are added for all courses that are eligible for inclusion in the grade point average and the result is divided by the total number of credit hours registered. The initial grade(s) of a course that is repeated or courses marked with EX are excluded from cumulative grade point average (GPA).

The letter grade A+ is assigned to recognize outstanding work and is achieved by around 2% of student. The letter grade A+ is taken into account based on the grade points listed in the above table as

II. Academic Standing:

At the end of each semester, students with an SPA of 3.75 or above are considered "Vehbi Koç Scholars" and students with an SPA and GPA of 3.25 or above are placed on the "Dean's Honor Roll".

III. Requirements for Graduation:

Undergraduate programs are designed to cover eight semesters (excluding the ELC Program and Medicine programs). Along with their programs' individual academic requirements, students are required to achieve a minimum cumulative average of 2.00 for graduation.
