## ACCREDITATION

Hawkeye Community College is a public community college founded in 1966, and is accredited by the Iowa Department of Education and the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. Prior to 1993, the college was known as Hawkeye Institute of Technology and all courses offered were technical credit.

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR AND CREDIT SYSTEM

Hawkeye Community College operates on a semester calendar (two semesters and one summer session per year). If the student has hours earned before the fall 1992 semester, all those credits have been converted to semester hours. All credit hours beginning with fall 1992 were earned and are represented in semester hours.

All Gates Business College and Cedar Rapids Business College courses are listed as quarter credits.

The Associate Degree Nursing, Dental Hygiene, Medical Laboratory Technician, Tool and Die/Moldmaking career programs and all courses in the Arts and Sciences Division have always operated on a semester calendar (two semesters and one summer session per year). Semester credit hours are on the transcript for any term or year listed.

Hawkeye transcripts present a complete and unabridged record of an individual student's courses and grades.

From 1966 through the spring quarter of 1971, the minimum program/major grade point average was 1.800 for awards.

Since the summer quarter of 1971, the minimum program/major grade point average is 2.000 for awards.

Term Dates: The terms of transcripts prior to July 1, 1981, are recorded using the calendar year, i.e., fall 80 is the fall quarter of 1980. From July 1, 1981, through June 30, 1985, terms are recorded by Fiscal Year, i.e., fall 82 is the fall quarter of 1981. For transcripts after July 1, 1985, terms are recorded by calendar year, i.e., fall 85 is the fall quarter of 1985.
