your ability to receive financial aid and enroll in the graduate portion of the MiT Program. Take the following steps to ensure that you graduate on time and can continue the program in Fall of 2024:

- Earn all your credits, including all 12 credits of the MiT Spring Start program.
- Apply to graduate with your undergraduate degree **by April 5, 2024** (week 1 of spring quarter). You can apply to graduate in MyEvergreen.
- **There is no need to re-order your transcript.** Graduate Admissions will order it for you. You should receive a form from them requesting permission to place this order on your behalf.
- Meet your conditional requirement by completing your K-12 public school classroom hours, your community-based organization hours, and documenting them on our hours log template, signed by your supervisors, by **August 1, 2024. Failure to complete this requirement will result in withdrawal from the program.**

We will be sending additional materials in January 2024 after the entire cohort has been admitted. For now, please accept our congratulations!
