Please contact MiT Assistant Director Kianee Lee (<a href="mailto:kianee.lee@evergreen.edu">kianee.lee@evergreen.edu</a>) if you need more time to make this deposit.

In addition, our records indicate that you may need to complete additional requirements to be considered fully admitted. If this looks incorrect to you, or if you have any questions about your conditions, please reach out to Kianee.

• Meet your conditional requirement by submitting your WEST B and WEST E/NES endorsement scores by *June 20<sup>th</sup>*, *2025* to <u>graduateadmissions@evergreen.edu</u>. Please note, the score must meet the threshold of a *190* for a NES endorsement test or *210* for a



WEST E endorsement test. Failure to complete this requirement may result in withdrawal from the program.

Please note, it is recommended the tests be taken no later than mid-May as it can take several weeks for the state to upload the test scores to the state's database and/or your account. *Please email Kianee with your testing dates ASAP*.
