- Apply to graduate with your undergraduate degree no later than week two of spring quarter. Failure to apply and receive your undergraduate degree prior to the start of the summer term (June 23rd, 2025) could result in you being withdrawn from the program.
- o **There is no need to re-order your transcript**. Graduate Admissions will order it for you. You should receive a form from them requesting permission to place this order on your behalf.
- Meet your conditional requirement by completing the WEST-B basic skills reading, writing, and math tests. The test scores need to be submitted and/or reflected in the states testing database by *June 20th, 2025.* Failure to complete this requirement may result in withdrawal from the program.
- Resubmit a signed copy of the classroom observation hours log by June 20th, 2025.
 Failure to complete this requirement may result in withdrawal from the program.
