- Submit a non-refundable \$100 tuition deposit either through your my.evergreen.edu account or by mail. Your deposit will be applied toward tuition. Please contact MiT Assistant Director Luis Apolaya Torres (luis.apolaya_torres@evergreen.edu) if you need more time to make this deposit.

In addition, our records indicate that you may need to complete additional requirements to be considered fully admitted. If this looks incorrect to you, or if you have any questions about your conditions, please reach out to Luis.



- Meet the following conditional requirements:
 - Official results from your WEST-B Exam or equivalent, submitted to the college by October 1, 2022. We strongly encourage you to submit them to the college by March 18, 2022. According to our records, you are missing the following portions of the WEST-B:
 - Math, Verbal, Writing
 - Hours log showing evidence of at least 40 hours of K-12 volunteer or paid work and 10 hours of community-based organization work, submitted to Luis by February 28, 2022. Currently, your submitted log shows completion of 34.5 hours in K-12 work and 10+ hours in community-based organization work. Feel free to reach out to Luis if you have any questions or concerns about meeting your hours requirement.

We will be sending additional materials in January 2022 after the entire cohort has been admitted. For now, please accept our congratulations!
