## 1. GRADING SYSTEM

Effective the 1961 Full Semester, the University adopted a 4.00 quality point scale, changing from the 3.00 scale. Effective the 1994 Fall Semester, W + grades were discontinued. Students receive a "W" grade for courses dropped. Grades of IP, W, P, NC, AU and Z are not computed in the GPA. Beginning the 2003 Summer Session, I and IX grades are computed as "F."

## 2. CREDIT HOURS

All credit hours are computed in semester hours. All transfer courses taken on the quarter system are converted to semester hours.

## 3. COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

In general, freshman courses are numbered in the 100 series: sophomore courses in the 200 series: junior courses in the 300 series: and senior courses in the 400 series. Several courses in the 400 series may be used to receive graduate credit. Graduate courses are numbered in the 500 and above series.

## 4. POLICY ON REPEATING COURSES

When a student repeats a course the transcript will show all grades. An adjusted GPA (not printed on transcript) will reflect only the last grade earned and will be used where necessary for graduation purposes only. All course grades, all hours attempted, and total quality points earned are used in calculating the cumulative GPA. Students should be aware that other four-year colleges and universities may not honor Grambling State University's Repeat Policy.

## 5. CONVERTED RECORDS

As of the 1991 Fall Semester, Grambling State University implemented an on-line electronic transcript system. Currently, all transcripts for students enrolled beginning with and after 1986 Spring Semester are processed using this system. A student enrolled both before and after 1986 Spring Semester may have two records. One record will be black on white produced by xerography. The other will be black ink on a laser printed form screened gold produced by the computer. Work completed between 1986 Spring Semester and 1991 Summer Session may be duplicated on both records.

## 6. USE RESTRICTION
