- Experience working with 6th, 7th, 8th or 9th graders, preferably in a middle school setting.
- A particular interest in working with highly capable students in a specialized setting.
- Strong personal skills in working with our teaching team, parents, and young adolescents.
- An understanding of and commitment to the NOVA school mission and philosophy.
- An understanding of and belief in the idea of a school as a supportive community.
