The Evergreen State College Spring Quarter 2005 Curriculum and Instructional Strategies for Exceptional Learners

This course will cover the advantages and limitations of instructional strategies and practices for teaching individuals with disabilities. This is part of a five course sequence of core special education courses (24 credits total) designed to enable students to make significant progress towards earning the Special Education endorsement.

Students will learn about modifications and accommodations to integrate exceptional learners into the general education curriculum, and how to design special curricula based on IEP assessment results, and the state's learning goals, EALRs and benchmarks. A practicum of 36 hours is required.
