

FALL 2010 STUDEBAKER FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

The Studebaker Fellowship was enabled by a generous donation from Mr. Andy Studebaker to the Master of Environmental Studies Program at The Evergreen State College. Its purposes are (a) to support graduate students in attending and participating in conferences that will further their professional interests, (b) to support expenses associated original work for a thesis, (c) to provide seed support for initiation, planning and support for conferences at Evergreen; and (d) to support extended field trips for classes or small groups.

For 2010-2011, there is a very small amount in the fund, so MES will only be offering one \$75 fellowship to the EcoDistricts Summit in Portland on October 25-26. Applications will be due October 13, 2010. The student conference fee is \$100 if you sign up before October 15. There will be no transportation included with this fellowship. Currently enrolled MES students are eligible to apply. Fellows will be asked to represent MES professionally at conference.
