The Studebaker Fellowship was enabled by a generous donation from Mr. Andy Studebaker to the Master of Environmental Studies Program at The Evergreen State College. Its purposes are (a) to support graduate students in attending and participating in conferences that will further their professional interests, (b) to support expenses associated original work for a thesis, (c) to provide seed support for initiation, planning and support for conferences at Evergreen; and (d) to support extended field trips for classes or small groups.

For 2010-2011, there is a very small amount in the fund, so MES will only be offering fellowships to students who wish to attend one of the conferences below. Applications will be due September 27, 2010. Funds will only be used to pay for conference registration fees. Currently enrolled MES students are eligible to apply.
