#### About the WEST

The purpose of the Washington Educator Skills Tests (WEST) is to assess the basic skills and content knowledge of prospective Washington educators. There are two types of WEST tests: the Washington Educator Skills Test—Basic® (WEST–B®), which measures basic skills in reading, mathematics, and writing, and the Washington Educator Skills Test—Endorsements™ (WEST–E™), which measures content knowledge required of candidates adding an endorsement to a new or existing Washington State teaching credential.
