## What is the WEST program?

The purpose of the Washington Educator Skills Tests (WEST) is to assess the basic skills and content knowledge of prospective Washington educators. There are two types of WEST tests: The Washington Educator Skills Test—Basic® (WEST-B®), which measures basic skills in reading, mathematics, and writing, and the Washington Educator Skills Tests—Endorsements (WEST-E), which measure the content knowledge required for endorsement for Washington teaching certificates.

## What's new in 2008-2009?

Beginning with the September 13, 2008, test administration, both the WEST-B and the new WEST-E will be administered together as one program.
