INTRODUCTION

As part of the Title II data collection and reporting process, preparation programs have the opportunity to review preliminary reports and files to verify the data being used to calculate the pass rates for Title II reporting. This manual includes instructions on how to interpret and use the reports and files that will be provided to assist preparation programs in the verification of data for Title II reporting. The appendices of this manual contain samples of the reports and files that will be provided to programs to verify and report Title II data.

Preparation programs can either accept the data being used to determine assessment and summary pass rates for the program, or submit revised data. In order for changes to be reflected in the final reports, revisions to the data must be made by submitting a revised Data Collection Worksheet. Once revisions are submitted and/or data has been accepted, final reports for preparation programs will be generated and posted.

Please refer to the Updated Title II Schedule posted on the https://www.educationreports.net Web site for information on the schedule for reviewing data, submitting revisions, and/or accepting data, and the date that final reports will be available.

EXPLANATION OF THE VERIFICATION REPORTS AND FILES

During the Title II Verification and Reporting period, the Data Collection Worksheet submitted by your program will be reposted to your

https://www.educationreports.net Web site directory. A sample Data Collection Worksheet (US123DTC2010.xls) is shown in **Appendix B-1**. In addition, folders containing reports and files generated from the data provided in the Data Collection Worksheet will be posted to the Web site directory.

Folder Types

- ◆ "Traditional within IHE"—Programs that prepare traditional candidates (T)
- ◆ "Alternative within IHE"—Programs that prepare alternative candidates
 within the institution (A)
- ◆ "Alternative outside IHE"—Programs that prepare candidates outside of an institution (Z).

Only folders for the types of candidates your program prepares (traditional and/or alternative) will be posted to the Web site directory. If your program prepares both alternative and traditional candidates, a folder for each type of candidate prepared will be posted for your review. Each folder will contain up to seven reports and files specific to that folder type (T, A, or Z).

- ◆ Status (yes or no) on whether the candidate took all tests in the certification route(s) indicated by the certification code on the Data Collection Worksheet (see **Appendix B-10** for certification mapping and tests)

This report allows you to verify the data in your Assessment and Summary Pass Rate Tables by verifying that candidates are reported and matched to appropriate tests. Use Mapping Table/Table of Tests provided in **Appendix B-10** to verify the tests and testing routes for candidates.

ES Matching Criteria

Extensive procedures are used to match the candidate data provided by institutions with Evaluation Systems testing data. A match is recorded for any candidate whose data match testing records in any of the following ways:

- Social security number + first 6 characters of last name + date of birth
- ♦ Social security number + first 4 characters of first name + date of birth
- First 6 characters of last name + first 4 characters of first name + date of birth
- ◆ First 6 characters of last name + first 4 characters of first name + 8 out of 9 digits of social security number

Last and first names are matched without regard to capitalization or punctuation (e.g., hyphens, apostrophes), and some other close matches are accepted (e.g., R_BERT for ROBERT, WILSQN for WILSON, RON for RONALD). Date of birth is matched without regard to the order of the month and day of birth (e.g., 05/09/80 is seen as matching 09/05/80), and a year of birth that is out of range (e.g., 1998) is considered to match any other year (e.g., 03/13/98 is seen as matching 03/13/77).

4. Unreported Not Found Report (US123_Unreported_Not_Found_T/A/Z.pdf) Appendix B-5

The Unreported Not Found Report includes all candidates submitted by your institution on the Data Collection Worksheet for this year or the previous two cohorts (2007–2008 and 2008–2009) who have not been found in testing records.

This report allows you to easily identify any candidates who were not matched to testing records and who will not be reported in the Title II reports for your program.

If you believe that a candidate has tested, check the demographic information you provided on the Data Collection Worksheet against the information the candidate provided when registering to test (it must match according to the matching criteria above).

5. Unreported Not Matched Report (US123_Unreported_Not_Matched_T/A/Z.pdf) Appendix B-6

The Unreported Not Matched Report includes all candidates submitted by your institution on the Data Collection Worksheet for this year or the previous two cohorts (2007–2008 and 2008–2009) who have been found in testing records but not been matched to tests in the route for the certification code(s) provided in the Data Collection Worksheet.

This report allows you to easily identify candidates who have not tested in the certification area indicated on the Data Collection Worksheet and who will not be included in Title II reports for your program.

If you believe that a candidate has tested in his/her certification area, check the certification code(s) you provided on the Data Collection Worksheet. The Mapping Table/Table of Tests provided in **Appendix B-10** allows you to verify the certification code(s) you provided and the associated tests and testing route(s).

6. Unreported Outside Date Window Report (US123_Unreported_ODW_T/A/Z.pdf) Appendix B-7

The Unreported Outside Date Window Report includes all candidates submitted by your institution on the Data Collection Worksheet for this year or the previous two cohorts (2007–2008 and 2008–2009) who have been matched only to tests taken outside the Title II matching date window.

This report allows you to easily identify candidates who will not be included in Title II reports for your program because they have taken tests only outside the Title II date window.

PROCEDURES FOR VERIFYING YOUR DATA

- 1. Review the assessment and summary pass rates for your preparation program:
 - Assessment Pass Rates Table (TableD1.xls/TableD3.xls/TableD5.xls)
 - ♦ Summary Pass Rates Table (TableD2.xls/TableD4.xls/TableD6.xls) (You may verify the data in these tables using the Pass Rate Verification File: US123_PassRates_Verification_T/A/Z.xls.)
- 2. Review the Reported Candidates Report and the Unreported Candidates reports.
- 3. Revise your data and resubmit the Data Collection Worksheet *or* accept your data.

To accept the data being used, select the "Acceptance" function from the Title II Menu page on the https://www.educationreports.net Web site.

To submit a revised Data Collection Worksheet, you should do the following:

- ◆ Download your previously submitted Data Collection Worksheet from the https://www.educationreports.net Web site directory.
- Review and revise the data on the Data Collection Worksheet.
- ◆ Re-upload the Data Collection Worksheet to the https://www.educationreports.net Web site.

Within two business days of resubmitting your worksheet, you will be sent an e-mail message indicating whether transmission of your data was successful or unsuccessful. If transmission was successful, within five business days of receiving the first message, you will receive another e-mail message indicating whether or not the contents of your worksheet have been accepted. Note that your revised worksheet must contain data for all of your candidates, as the new worksheet will supersede all previous versions of your Data Collection Worksheet.

At the close of the period for data verification, ES will match to testing records the data you submitted on your revised or accepted Data Collection Worksheet. Based on your final data submission, final Title II reports and files will be produced and posted to the program Web site on the date indicated on the updated Title II Schedule.

Please note: even if you do not request revisions, the final version of the Title II reports could have minor differences in data if, for instance, candidates submitted corrections (e.g., to name or social security number) that caused additional matches to be made.

If you believe an error has been made in calculating your pass rates, you may report any discrepancies to the your state's Title II Contact and provide documentation of any error that you believe exists (e.g., copy of a score report). Disputed information will be corroborated by your state's Title II Contact.
