From the college:

Mud Bay Road (West?) to Highway 101 or to Madrona Beach Road (take a right onto Madrona Beach, just before Highway 101).

If on 101, go toward Shelton. Exit at Steamboat Island Road exit. Take a right off the exit...follow that road for about a block, the road forks, jog left at the fork (you are on 32nd Ave). My house is in the middle of the block, on the left (brick and siding/privacy hedges in front, first driveway past the basketball hoop).

If on Madrona Beach, follow along Eld Inlet, go up the hill. Your first left is 32nd Ave (not marked on this side of sign). Take a left. House is in the middle of the block, on right. See above.
