LOCATION The Computer Center is located on the main 2nd floor of the Library building in L2606 behind the Library.

GENERAL ACCESS The Computer Center is the College's general access computer facility. We have no requirements about which program you're in or what you're studying, whether you're full- or part-time, day or night, graduate or undergraduate. There are no proficiency tests for the use of our equipment. Use is on a "first come, first served" basis, with a few exceptions. There are no additional fees for using the Computer Center.

HOURS Regular hours: Mon–Thu 7 A.M. – 2 A.M.; Fri 7 A.M. – 10 P.M.; Sat 9 A.M. – 10 P.M.; Sun 12 Noon – 2 A.M. (When school is in session.) See our website for holiday and break hours.

ASSISTANCE Student Consultants ("Green Vests") are always available when the Computer Center is open.

COMPUTING The Computer Center is composed of four areas and also offers wireless access:

General Computing Classroom (GCC) 1 & 2

- 30 new Windows/Pentium systems, plus several scanners (GCC2 has 26 computers).
- Software includes Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Access & PowerPoint), web browsers, Dreamweaver, SPSS, Flash, Photoshop, and various curricular software which may change with program needs.

Macintosh Classroom (MCC)

- 25 Macintosh G4 iMac systems, plus several scanners.
- Software includes Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, & PowerPoint), web browsers, Photoshop, FinalCutPro, Flash, Dreamweaver, iMovie, InDesign, and more.

Advanced Computing Classroom (ACC)

- 25 systems ("dual boot" – running Windows XP and Linux) with a variety of programming environments.
- Oriented towards Computer Science
- Restricted Access (for computer science students).

Cluster Area includes:

- Three printers (networked to all our computers)
- 24 Windows & Macintosh systems
- Four scanners
- Wireless laptop commons
- Digital Video, Graphics, and Audio stations
- Accessibility station
